Maddie's Fund Summary Fiscal Year 2009-10

In Fiscal Year 2009-10, Maddie's Fund distributed \$11.4 million in grant funds. 156 grants were awarded to 343 animal welfare organizations, 168 veterinary hospitals, 7 universities and 1 veterinary medical association in 42 states and the District of Columbia.

Lifesaving Accomplishments:

Our eight community collaborative projects found new homes for a total of 81,103 dogs and cats; performed 29,268 spay/neuter surgeries and reduced euthanasia by a total of 39,702 deaths.

New Grants:

Grants totaling \$317,000 were given to colleges of veterinary medicine.

\$1.2 million was given to special projects including The Shelter Pet Project, Maddie's[®] Matchmaker Adoptathon, and Maddie's[®] Customer Service Award.

Fourteen new Starter Grants, including 10 Shelter Data Grants, 1 Business Plan Grant, 2 Pet Evaluation Matrix Grants and 1 Strategic Planning Grant were awarded for a total of \$321,000.

Targeted Spay/Neuter Programs in Duval County, Florida, Loudon & Monroe Counties, Tennessee, Madison County, Alabama and Northern Nevada received \$2.6 million in funding.
