- Lines C & J are not equivalent because included in the totals on line J are 1) four dogs the Richmond SPCA mistakenly transferred from Richmond Animal Care & Control, but that RAC&C did not record at intake a second time and 2) two stray dogs and one stray cat that the Richmond SPCA transferred to RAC&C, but that RAC&C reflected as public intakes since they were stray and not belonging to the Richmond SPCA.
