## **What Cat Town Provides**

- A socializing plan for the cat and guidance on implementing it;
- Ongoing support with any issues that arise with the cat;
- All necessary supplies, including litter and litter boxes, food, cat beds and toys, dishes and water bowls as needed;
- Payment for all medical care (which is to be provided by Cat Town's approved veterinarian, Claremont Veterinary Hospital, and authorized by Cat Town in advance);
- Marketing your foster cat when he/she is ready for adoption, and facilitating any introduction where the potential adopter and foster cat seem like an appropriate match.

## Your Responsibility as the Foster Caregiver

- Provide a safe, peaceful environment for your foster cat in an appropriate space for the socializing plan (e.g. extremely shy cats should be kept to one room until they are interacting with confidence);
- Keep the cat indoors at all times with windows secured and screens only one-inch wide so the cat may not scratch through and potentially escape;
- Provide a scooped litterbox, fresh water and food (provided by Cat Town) on a daily basis;
- Provide Cat Town with regular updates about the cat's progress, and observe closely for any possible health or behavior issues. Immediately inform Cat Town in case of any of the following:
  - Lack of appetite (adult cats should eat the equivalent of at least one half cup of wet or dry food each day);
  - Change in appetite or water intake;
  - Lethargy, or change in energy level;
  - Agitation or aggressive behavior;
  - o Inappropriate elimination or marking;
  - o Frequent visiting or posturing in the litterbox with little produced.
- Transport the cat to a veterinarian, when necessary (Cat Town will provide transportation if the foster is unable to do so);
- Administer any medications prescribed by a veterinarian or inform Cat Town if unable to do so;
- Inform Cat Town when the cat seems ready for adoption, sharing information about the cat on Cat Town's foster information form.
- Provide Cat Town with electronic photos and/or videos of the cat or allow a Cat Town volunteer into your home to take such photos so that he/she may be publicized for adoption;
- Allow Cat Town representatives to meet with potential adopters at your home (so the adopters can see the cat when acclimated and comfortable);
- Provide Cat Town with at least one week's notice if you are unable to continue fostering the cat;
- Foster cat is Cat Town's responsibility and may not be abandoned, given, or sold to any other person or organization;
- Cat Town may visit the home or remove the cat from the foster home at any time.
