Abscess	Gingivitis (moderate to severe requiring dental or medication)
Allergies (moderate to severe)	Head trauma
Amputation	Heart murmur (low grade, high grade)
Anal sac disorder	Heartworm infection
Asthma	Hepatic lipidosis
Atopy	Herpes
Autoimmune disease (mild to severe)	Hyperadrenocorticalism (Cushing's Disease)
Bladder stones	Hyperthyroidism
Blindness	Hypothyroidism
Burns	Hypoadrenocorticalism (Addison's Disease)
Cardiomyopathy (mild to moderate)	Inflammatory bowel disease (mild, moderate to severe)
Cherry eye	Keratitis
Chronic ear infection	Limb injury or fracture (mild to moderate, severe)
Chronic joint pain (moderate to severe)	Liver surgery
Chronic renal failure (mild to moderate)	Neoplasia (mild to moderate)
Chronic rhinitis sinusitis	Neurological disorder
Coccidiosis	Osteoarthritis (debilitating & requiring treatment to control pain)
Congestive heart failure (mild to severe)	Pancreatitis
Conjunctivitis infectious etiology (moderate to severe)	Panleukopenia
Constipation (Chronic)	Parvovirus infection
Corneal ulceration	Periodontal disease (moderate to severe)
Cryptosporidium (bug that causes diarrhea)	Pneumonia (mild to severe)
Deafness	Ricketts
Defuse demodectic mange	Sarcoptic mange
Degloving	Seizure disorder
Dental issues requiring treatment	Spinal cord injury
Dermatophytosis (Ringworm)	Stomatitis
Dermatitis requiring antibiotics	Tapeworm infection
Diabetes mellitus (mild to moderate, severe)	Tick-borne infection
Diarrhea (acute > 1 week duration, chronic)	Tracheobronchitis infection
Distemper virus infection	Ulcer
Ear infection	Umbilical hernia
Ear surgery	Upper respiratory infection (moderate to severe)
Emaciation secondary to malnutrition	Urinary tract infection
Eosinophilic granuloma complex	Vomiting (chronic high frequency >1xday or low frequency)
